Olympic Gold Medalist Henry Cejudo to Present at the 6th Annual “Premios Juventud” Youth Awards

Scottsdale, AZ, JULY 14, 2009 – Olympic gold medalist Henry Cejudo, is slated to present at *Univision’s 6th Annual Premios Juventud Youth Awards* on July 16th. Henry is the son of Mexican immigrants. The youngest of 6 children, Henry's early childhood was spent moving from state to state as a result of his family's hardships and circumstances. Henry eventually settled in Phoenix, Arizona. Fortunately, the hardships encountered during his childhood motivated Henry to focus his full attention and efforts on school and athletics. By the time Henry had reached Maryville High School in Phoenix, he was dominating local competition. After Henry won his second Arizona State Wrestling Championship, he was approached to go to the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs, Colorado where he could train with future Olympic hopefuls.

Henry made the decision to relocate to Colorado and follow his dreams of becoming an Olympic Champion. Mirroring his accomplishments in Arizona, he added two State Wrestling Championship wins to his record while attending Coronado High in Colorado. Upon graduating, Henry began training full time at the Olympic Training Center to prepare for the 2008 Olympic Games. Henry Cejudo went on to win the gold in Beijing, becoming the youngest American to win a gold medal in Wrestling.
